

**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN
REDONDO BEACH UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT
AND
REDONDO BEACH TEACHERS ASSOCIATION
Special Education Advisory Committee MOU**

June 28, 2024

This Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") is entered into by and between Redondo Beach Unified School District ("District") and Redondo Beach Teachers Association (RBTA), (collectively referred to herein as the "Parties") regarding special education for the 2024-2025 school year.

The parties agree to the following:


Over the course of the 2024-2025 school year, the RBSEAC will discuss and provide input and suggestions in the development of the RBUSD special education programs and strategic plan. The RBSEAC will make recommendations to the 2025 RBUSD and RBTA negotiation teams.

The following measures will be in place during the 2024-2025 school year:

1. The caseload for a special education teacher shall adhere to all applicable federal and state law. In the event any caseload for any special education teacher exceeds twenty-five (25) students, a conference shall be held between the affected teacher and their direct supervisor to discuss needed support.
2. Special education staff, including psychologists, are strongly encouraged to seek support and guidance from their site administrator(s) or direct supervisor regarding concerns about their caseload, pending cases, or priority of assigned tasks.
