PVFA and the District met today and exchanged initial bargaining proposals.

PVFA Proposed

- An increase to the certificated salary schedules
- Stipend adjustments to reflect the current salary schedule
- Involuntary transfer & reassignment language revisions, particularly in regard to Special Education
- Language enhancements for Special Education

The District Proposed

- A defined workday
- Requirement for teachers to use district technology to report student progress

The Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) regarding elementary school P.E. was extended until June 2018.

Both sides await the Governor's May revise for further verification of the budget numbers. The PVFA Rep Council will discuss next steps at their April 11 meeting, and reps will hold site meetings to solicit bargaining unit member input. Look for notifications about those meetings in the next couple of weeks.
