2014-2015 Bargaining Season Opens

- ❖ The PVFA Bargaining Team met with the district leadership on June 11th to present the PVFA proposal which included our request for increased salary and benefit compensation. Additionally, our PVFA proposal included contract language clarification for both special education transfers/reassignments and elementary prep time.
- ❖ On July 11th, the District team presented budget information that will have an impact on a contract settlement (CalSTRS, LCFF, and one time Common Core funding). Overall, the District acknowledged that the financial outlook is positive.
- ❖ The District was not ready to discuss the contract today because they want to wait for the unaudited actuals. (Unaudited actuals = the final budget report for last school year). These are the numbers they want to work from before getting into a compensation & benefits discussion.
- ❖ PVFA agreed to meet in September to discuss the language aspect of the contract, and again in October when the unaudited actuals are complete to discuss the financial aspect of the contract.
- ❖ While the Bargaining Team knows that everyone is anxious for a quick settlement, we ask for your patience while we await currently unknown budget specifics; however, we do expect a quick resolution after the October meeting.
