Prop. 30 Passes! Most School Days are Restored!

- ❖ The PVFA bargaining team met with the district leadership on November 15th & December 6th to discuss the passing of Prop. 30 and how it impacts the PVFA Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the district.
- ❖ Last spring, the bargaining team negotiated a formula for restoring days based on state funding and the base revenue limit (BRL). The team is pleased to note that the district honored our formula which results in more days of school!
- ❖ PVFA agreed that the following days will be restored as instructional days: January 28th, February 8th, April 22nd, and May 17th. These days will be paid in a lump sum off schedule in the February 1st paycheck.
- ❖ Additionally, there will be a change in the calendar for May 24th. It will be a student free day and a minimum day for teacher inservice.
- ❖ June 10 is the last remaining furlough day. This is not a workday.
- ❖ A special thanks to those PVFA members who phone banked and participated in precinct walks. Due to these individuals' efforts as well as all of SBUT/CTA's efforts, Prop. 30 passed and our school year has been lengthened!
