On Sunday, the CTA State Council General Assembly gathered for the official launch of our signature gathering phase of the Schools & Communities First ballot initiative. This important initiative will appear on the ballot in November of 2020. CTA has pledged 150,000 signatures and we fully plan to meet and surpass that goal. This initiative will raise 11 billion dollars annually, 5 billion of which will go to education. This initiative would protect all homeowners and small businesses and only

With successful passage, these companies' properties will be reassessed so that they may pay their fair share like the rest of us have been all these years.
